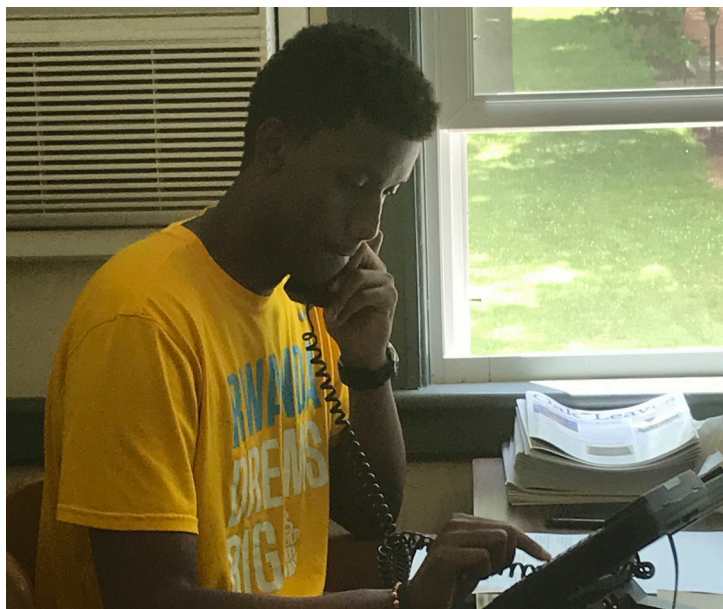

Herzog Lecture series honors Daniel's father, a distinguished chemist and pharmaceutical executive who was instrumental in developing several popular antibiotic and anti-inflammatory drugs. The 2018 speaker was **Paul Grant, PhD '53**, who presented, "A Life in Physics and Beyond." Paul was part of the IBM team engaged in the discovery of high temperature superconductivity and is a coholder of the international patent dealing with the preparation of these materials. Upon retiring from IBM in 1993, he achieved appointment as a Science Fellow at the Electric Power Research Institute in Palo Alto where he collaborated with the Department of Energy on power applications of superconductivity, smart grid technologies, and climate change mitigation strategies.
